The Nene Valley Saxons is an interactive visit including:

- A 1-hour workshop
- A 1-hour tour
- Self-guided time in the Museum
- Lunch
- Play area time

YOUR TOUR

Your 1-hour tour focuses on Chester House throughout time. We explore how the site has been used throughout the last 10,000 years and finishes with a look at the excavation.

The tour is activity led and learners will:

- Complete a chronology walk
- Interpret Geophysics and orienteering.
- Scent identification

This is an all-weather tour so we recommend learners bring/wear outdoor clothing and footwear.

YOUR WORKSHOP

Learners will explore what life was like for Saxons in the Nene Valley. We use original objects that were found in the local area and complete activities that encourage learners to think like an archaeologist. Learners will:

- Examine a Saxon bead and make their own.
- Write in runes.
- Handle original objects and try to identify their purpose.
