## YOUR WORKSHOP

Learners will explore how archaeologists learn about the past. We use original objects that were found in the local area and complete activities that encourage learners to think like an archaeologist. Learners will:

- Practice techniques similar to flint knapping and understand how archaeologists learn from flint scatters
- Examine and compare original objects.

## YOUR TOUR

Your 1-hour tour focuses on Chester House throughout time. We explore how the site has been used throughout the last 10,000 years and finishes with a look at the excavation.

The tour is activity led and learners will:

- Complete a chronology walk
- Interpret Geophysics and orienteering.
- Scent identification
