ABOUT THE VISIT

The Nene Valley Romans is one of our most popular school trips. This interactive visit includes:

- A 1-hour workshop
- A 1-hour tour
- Self-guided time in the Museum
- Lunch
- Play area time

YOUR WORKSHOP

Learners will explore what life was like for Romans in the Nene Valley. Learners will:

- handle **original objects** and try to identify their purpose.
- read and write Roman curses using Roman ink.
- create a Roman clay oil lamp to take home.

We recommend teachers bring a container to carry the oil lamps back to school.

YOUR TOUR

Your 1-hour tour focuses on Chester House during the Roman period. We explore how archaeologists know about the past years and finish with a look at the excavation.

The tour is activity led and learners will:

- Complete a chronology walk
- Interpret Geophysics and orienteering.
- Scent identification

The tour will last one hour.

This is an all-weather tour so we recommend learners bring/wear outdoor clothing and footwear.
